**Outdoor Wood Boiler/Furnace Regulations**  
(please see Local Law #3 of 2010 for complete regulations)

\*Operated between September 1 and May 15\*

\*All outdoor wood boilers/furnaces shall have a smoke stack or chimney that extends at least eighteen (18) feet above the ground of the boiler/furnace\*

\*There shall be a collapse zone around the outdoor wood boiler/furnace of at least twenty (20) feet from the boiler and its structures to any adjacent structure\*
